**Re: Eastern Alberta DC Transmission Line
Minor Route Adjustment, North of Lamont Area
S½ 20 in 56-19-W4M**

In March 2011, ATCO Electric submitted a Preferred Route and Alternative Route Segments to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) for the proposed 500 kilovolt (kV) Eastern Alberta direct current (DC) transmission line between the Gibbons-Redwater and Brooks areas. ATCO Electric continues to identify site-specific features that may affect the placement of the transmission line, and make minor adjustments as appropriate. This letter is to notify landowners and other interested parties within 800 metres of the proposed right-of-way about a planned route adjustment. ATCO Electric plans to file the details with the AUC in September 2011. **Please contact us if you have any questions, comments or concerns about this route adjustment** (see contact details below).

Details of the route adjustment(s)

The attached map shows the location of a proposed route adjustment for the Preferred Route. In S½ 20-56-19-W4M the Preferred Route is located 55 metres south of the east-west quarter line, then turns south in SE 20 at node CD33 to parallel the north-south quarter line. An adjustment is required to avoid the placement of a corner tower in a wet area in SE 20 and to provide separation from an abandoned wellhead in SW 20. For the adjusted route, the planned corner at node CD33 is shifted approximately 75 metres south to node CD33s, and a slight angle is made at the planned tower location at node CD32c. The adjusted alignment affects a single span of line (approximately 365 metres in length), requires no additional towers, and is located within the same properties as the original route. The alignment for the Alternative Route Segment remains unchanged at this time.
