**Re: Eastern Alberta DC Transmission Line  
Minor Route Adjustment, East of Holden Area  
Sections 4 and 9 in 49-15-W4M**

In March 2011, ATCO Electric submitted a Preferred Route and Alternative Route Segments to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) for the proposed 500 kilovolt (kV) Eastern Alberta direct current (DC) transmission line between the Gibbons-Redwater and Brooks areas. ATCO Electric continues to identify site-specific features that may affect the placement of the transmission line, and make minor adjustments as appropriate. This letter is to notify landowners and other interested parties within 800 metres of the proposed right-of-way about a planned route adjustment. ATCO Electric plans to file the details with the AUC in September 2011. **Please contact us if you have any questions, comments or concerns about this route adjustment** (see contact details below).

**Details of the route adjustment(s)**

The attached map shows the location of a proposed route adjustment for the Preferred Route. In Section 9-49-15-W4M the Preferred Route straddles the north-south quarter line to node D144, then angles east into Section 4 to an alignment 120 metres east of the quarter line. The adjusted alignment is located within the same properties, but the route angles west then east of the quarter line (nodes D141-D142-D143) to enable the crossing of the pipeline corridor in Section 9, then remains 100 metres east of the quarter line (D143 to D145) in S½ 9 and N½ 4 to enable the crossing of a wet area and Highway 14. The adjustment alignment rejoins the original alignment immediately south of the highway (node D145s).
